About Reign in Rhythm Cheer Co.

Reign in Rhythm Cheer Company is a competitive cheer program built on precision, passion, and determination. We combine elite training with creativity and confidence to develop athletes who lead with strength on and off the mat. Our mission is to build champions who move with purpose, perform with excellence, and Reign with pride. From foundational skills to advanced skills, our athletes grow in skill, character, and confidence, all while embracing the teamwork and dedication that define Reign in Rhythm.

Programs

Show Teams:

Show Teams or Exhibition Teams are our youngest performers! A non-competitive team that focuses on learning cheer fundamentals, building confidence, and shining in fun exhibitions and performances.

Novice Teams:

Novice teams are ratings-based competitive teams that compete with restricted tumbling and stunting skills. Routines are shorter than a prep or elite team and skills are limited. It is a great program if your athlete is younger, but wants to also start learning the competition and commitment aspect of All-Star. Novice teams are typically for athletes ages 5 to 12

Prep Teams:

The next step up from our novice squads, Prep Teams receive advanced training and guidance similar to our Elite Teams, preparing athletes for higher-level competition and skill development. Athletes will compete at both local and out of town competitions. Routines are shorter, like Novice teams, but they have less restrictions and compete for 1st place against other teams in their division. Prep teams are for athletes ages 5 to 16.

Elite Teams:

Our elite program is the most intense and demanding program that we offer. Elite athletes focus on advanced skills, teamwork, and elite-level routines. These routines are a full 2 minutes and 30 seconds. The routines are faster, more difficult, and require more practice. Throughout the season, athletes compete at select events with the goal of earning a bid to All-Star Worlds. Elite teams' ages range from 6-19 levels 1 through 6.

Tumbling Classes:

All required and optional tumbling classes are provided through Mavericks Gymnastics and are **NOT** included in Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company tuition. Families must register through Mavericks

Gymnastics via iClass and are responsible for following all facility policies, agreements, and payment requirements associated with their account. All waivers and billing terms are accepted at the time of registration through iClass. Placement on a team may require enrollment in specific tumbling classes as determined by coaching staff.

Fundamentals:

FUNDamentals is a program that introduces athletes ages 3 to 12 to All-Star in a fun, non-competitive environment. In this 12 week class, athletes will learn a basic routine consisting of jumps, tumbling, a mini dance, and entry level stunts. The routine will be performed for friends and family on the final day of class. Practices are held once a week for one hour.

Camps & Clinics

Reign in Rhythm offers specialized camps and clinics throughout the year designed to help athletes build skills, confidence, and teamwork. Each session focuses on targeted areas such as tumbling, stunting, performance, and leadership providing a fun, fast-paced environment for growth and progress. Clinics and camps are scheduled based on availability and may vary throughout the season depending on travel, team needs, and facility access.

Private Lessons

Private lessons are available to athletes seeking additional one-on-one training in areas such as tumbling, stunting, jumps, or performance skills. All private lessons must be scheduled directly based on the desired coach's availability and cannot conflict with or interfere with mandatory team practices.

Please note: Accounts must be current and in good standing before scheduling or participating in private lessons. *Requires Registration

Uniforms, Practice Wear, & Other Fees

ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE

The Annual Registration Fee is \$45 per athlete, per year. This fee covers liability insurance fees incurred by each athlete. The Annual Registration Fee will be charged on or before first scheduled practice/ class if not already paid in the previous 12 months.

Please note: This fee is NOT included in your initial tuition & deposit payment.

TRYOUT FEE

A \$50 non-refundable tryout fee is required for all athletes 7yrs up to open age athletes participating in Reign in Rhythm Cheer Co. team evaluations. \$25 non-refundable tryout fee required for ages 3-6

Please note: The tryout fee does not guarantee placement on a team and is non-refundable under any circumstances, including withdrawal or inability to attend.

COMMITMENT FEE

A \$200 Commitment Fee is required to secure an athlete's placement on a Reign in Rhythm team for the season. This fee confirms the athlete's spot.

Please note: The commitment fee is non-refundable and must be paid in full to officially hold a roster position.

LATE FEES

A \$35 late fee will be charged on the 15th of each month for unpaid tuition. Email reminders will be sent to past due accounts before the 15th of each month.

QUITTING FEE

\$500 Quitting Fee will be applied to any athlete who commits to a Reign in Rhythm Cheer Company team and later chooses to withdraw before the end of the season..This policy is in place to uphold the commitment each athlete makes to their teammates, coaches, and the program as a whole. Every athlete's dedication impacts team structure, choreography, stunt groups, and overall performance readiness. Respecting everyone's time and effort is essential to maintaining the integrity and success of our program.

Please note: The quitting fee applies once an athlete accepts placement and signs the season agreement, regardless of participation duration.

****MILITARY EXCEPTION**

For families in the military who receive official orders requiring relocation, a refund may be issued up to one (1) month of tuition paid prior to withdrawal, upon submission of official documentation. All other fees and tuition payments remain non-refundable.

UNIFORM

Competition uniforms for the 2026–2027 season are estimated to range from \$200–\$400 depending on team level and final design selections. All athletes are required to purchase an official Reign In Rhythm competition uniform.

Uniforms, shoes, and custom socks fees are due by August 3, 2026.

Due to the frequency of use and the performance nature of cheer uniforms and cheer shoes, normal wear and tear should be expected throughout the season. Replacement costs for lost, damaged, or outgrown uniform pieces are the responsibility of the athlete's family.

PRACTICE WEAR

All athletes are required to purchase official Reign In Rhythm practice wear to maintain a unified and professional team appearance at practices.

Practice set requirements by team level:

- **Show & Novice teams:** 1 practice set — **\$55**
- **Prep & Elite teams:** 2 practice sets — **\$85 total**

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS:

Athlete travel and accommodations are NOT included in tuition, or other gym fees. Some out of town competitions are Stay to Play, meaning accommodations must be booked directly through the competition's booking agency. We will release hotel booking information via Band, once it is available to the gym. *All athletes competing will be expected to arrive at out of city/ state competitions by a certain date and time.

Explanation of Costs & Fees

Card On File Requirement

All families are required to maintain a valid credit or debit card on file. Any outstanding balances not received by the stated due date may be automatically charged to the card on file to keep accounts current and avoid disruption to athlete participation.

Payment Schedule

Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company's All-Star Program is an 11-month commitment, running from May 29, 2026 through Nationals in April 2027. Families are expected to follow all financial deadlines and obligations throughout the season.

Monthly tuition is automatically drafted on the 1st of each month. A grace period is provided through the 15th of the month. Any tuition not received by the 15th will incur a \$35 late fee.

Athletes with outstanding balances beyond the grace period may become ineligible to participate in practices, choreography, or competitions until their account is brought current.

Accounts that remain significantly past due may result in delayed competition registration or removal from an event at the discretion of Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company.

Timely payments are essential to ensure team registrations, facility use, and overall program operations continue smoothly throughout the season.

Throughout the season, additional charges may occur, including extra competition-related expenses, end-of-season fees, late fees, or similar program costs. Families will receive advance notice via email, text message, and/or Band prior to any additional charges being processed.

Monthly Tuition

Monthly tuition supports team instruction and program operations throughout the season and includes:

- Routine choreography
- Music
- Competition fees
- Coaches fees
- Team training
- Group stunt training (Prep and Elite teams only)

Tuition is calculated evenly across the season and is not prorated for months with fewer practice dates, holidays, athlete absences, or schedule variations.

Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of each month. A \$35 late fee will be applied after the 15th if payment has not been received.

Stunt Group Training

Prep and Elite athletes are required to attend a monthly one-hour stunt group training session with their assigned stunt group. These sessions focus on improving timing, technique, and consistency for practices and performances.

Attendance is mandatory for all stunt group members. A session will only count when all athletes in the stunt group are present and the training is signed off by a coach.

Group stunt training is included in monthly tuition for Prep and Elite teams.

Discounts

PAY IN FULL:

Families who opt to pay for their season in full will receive 10% off their All-Star tuition. **Pay in full does NOT include the Annual Registration Fee, Tryout Fee, End of Season Fees, or any other separate costs.

**Pay in full must be completed between May 29th ,2026 and August 1st , 2026.

**Pay in full can be completed via cash, check, or card.

SIBLING DISCOUNT:

Families with multiple athletes participating on All-Star teams are eligible for the following monthly tuition discounts per month:

- \$30 off the second athlete
- \$20 off the third athlete
- \$15 off the fourth athlete

In addition, families will receive \$100 off the Commitment Fee for each additional athlete after the first.

Sibling discounts do not apply to the Annual Registration Fee, Tryout Fees, End-of-Season Fees, tumbling, jump or stunt class tuition, or any other separately billed program costs.

CLASS DISCOUNT:

Prep and Elite athletes can receive \$10 off/ month on all Reign In Rhythm Cheer Co. classes through April 30th 2027. Show and Novice athletes can receive \$5 off/month on all Reign In Rhythm Cheer Co. classes through April 30th 2027

**If your athlete is in more than one extra class, you may apply the class discount to all class enrollments.

**Class Discounts do NOT apply to Tumbling Classes scheduled through Maverick Gymnastics.

CAMPS & CLINICS

No general discounts will be applied to camps or clinics. Our Ambassadors and Junior Coaches will continue to receive their individual discounts based on their tier level and consistency within the program.

TRYOUTS

Tryout Registration Requirement – Maverick Gymnastics

All athletes must be registered through iClassPro at Maverick Gymnastics prior to participating in evaluations. This registration is required for facility use, athlete waivers, and safety compliance.

Athletes who are not registered in the Maverick Gymnastics system may not be permitted to participate in tryouts until registration is completed.

We recommend completing this step at least 24 hours before evaluations to avoid delays at check-in.

WHAT TO EXPECT

At tryouts, athletes will be assessed on their individual skills, including tumbling, jumps, strength, body control, and overall execution. Each athlete will also be required to learn and perform a short dance. In addition to technical ability, coaches will consider body language, attitude, coachability, teamwork, and overall athletic readiness to ensure that each team fosters a positive, productive, and supportive environment.

FLYER EVALUATION

Prospective Flyers are required to complete a Flyer Evaluation, an exciting opportunity to showcase advanced skills, strength, and technique. This evaluation allows coaches to identify athletes with the ability to perform the skills necessary for a specific level.

TEAM SELECTION

At Reign in Rhythm, our goal is to find every athlete a placement on the team that best fits their skill level, while also building strong, cohesive, and productive teams.

During the tryout process, you may receive a phone call suggesting that your athlete tryout for a higher or lower level to ensure the best fit.

Please note: Signing up for a specific tryout level does not guarantee placement on a team of that level. Coaches make final decisions based on skills, teamwork, and overall team balance.

SKILL MAINTENANCE

Athletes are placed on teams that best match their current skills, performance level, and overall readiness. Throughout the season, athletes are expected to maintain and continue developing the skills required for their assigned team.

If an athlete is consistently unable to perform or retain required skills, the coaching staff reserves the right to:

- Recommend additional classes or private lessons to strengthen skill proficiency, or
- Reassign the athlete to a team that better aligns with their current ability level.
- All placement and movement decisions are made with the athlete's safety, progress, and team success in mind.

Tryout Breakdown

Tiny and Mini age athletes will attend **one day of tryouts** lasting approximately **1.5 hours**. During this session, participants will complete a jump and tumbling evaluation, followed by a short motion and choreography segment to assess listening skills, coordination, and their ability to learn material quickly.

Youth through Senior age athletes will attend **three days of tryouts**. Throughout these sessions, participants will complete jump and tumbling evaluations, a motion and choreography segment, and a group performance to assess overall skill level, performance quality, and their ability to learn and retain material.

Team placements are determined at the discretion of the coaching staff based on athlete performance, readiness, attitude, and overall team needs. Participation in tryouts does **not** guarantee placement on a team.

Day 1 – Introduction, Choreography & Group Assignments

Athletes will meet the coaching staff, review expectations, begin jump technique instruction, and learn the tryout choreography.

Day 2 – Choreography Review & Evaluations

Athletes will review choreography taught on Day 1 and be evaluated on strength, body control, execution, and performance quality.

Flyer evaluations will take place at the conclusion of Day 2.

Day 3 – Final Evaluations

Athletes will return in designated groups to perform their jumps, tumbling, choreography, and overall execution for final assessment.

Make-up evaluations are reserved **only** for athletes with a pre-approved, excused scheduling conflict that prevents attendance on all scheduled tryout days.

Callbacks may be issued at the discretion of the coaching staff for athletes who require additional evaluation prior to final team placement decisions.

What to Wear & Bring

Athletes must arrive dressed and prepared for tryouts. Athletes not dressed in the required attire may be asked to return on another day.

Required Attire

- Plain black sports bra or athletic shirt
- Black shorts
- Cheer shoes
- Hair in a high ponytail with a black bow
- No jewelry
- No gum
- No cell phones

Bring

- Personal water bottle
- A positive attitude and readiness to work

Parent Viewing Policy

To ensure a focused and fair evaluation environment for all athletes, parents and spectators are **not permitted inside the tryout evaluation area** unless otherwise specified by Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company staff.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The competition schedule at Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company runs from November through April for Show & Novice teams and November through May (depending on National event) for Prep and Elite teams. Attendance at every competition for your athlete's team is MANDATORY. A finalized competition schedule will be released during the summer.

While competition attendance is expected for all team members, Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company reserves the right to adjust competition participation if necessary due to athlete readiness, roster availability, financial standing, injury, safety considerations, event changes, or scheduling conflicts beyond program control.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENT & EXPECTATIONS

To uphold the standard of excellence within Reign in Rhythm Cheer Co. All athletes and families are expected to adhere to the following guidelines throughout the season:

1. Arrival & Pickup Policy

Athletes should arrive **5 minutes prior** to their scheduled class or practice time and be picked up promptly at dismissal.

If you anticipate arriving late for drop-off or pick-up, please notify staff in advance when possible.

For athlete safety:

- Students must remain inside the building until escorted to their vehicle
- Drive slowly and carefully in the parking lot
- Do not leave children unattended in vehicles at any time

Athletes arriving more than **20 minutes late** to any scheduled Mavericks classes may not be permitted to participate in class and may instead receive a makeup token when applicable.

Athletes are expected to arrive on time and prepared for all scheduled Reign In Rhythm practices. Late arrivals may result in additional conditioning due to missed instruction and team training time. Repeated or excessive tardiness may impact an athlete's position within the routine and can result in placement as an alternate or removal from the team if attendance expectations are not consistently met.

Weather Closure Clause

In the event of severe weather, facility closure, or circumstances beyond program control, practices may be rescheduled or converted to alternative training sessions when possible. Updates will be communicated through Band and official program communication channels.

2. Attendance & Punctuality

- Athletes must arrive on time, fully dressed, and ready to begin practice at the scheduled start time.
- Three (3) unexcused absences may result in placement as an alternate or removal from performances.
- Athletes placed as alternates remain full members of the team and are expected to attend all practices, events, and competitions. Alternates may be moved into routine positions at any time during the season at the discretion of the coaching staff.
- All excused absences (such as illness, family emergency, or school function) must be communicated to the coach at least 24 hours in advance when possible.
- Excessive tardiness (3 or more instances) will be treated as an unexcused absence.

3. Practice Expectations

- Athletes must attend all practices unless excused. Missing practice prior to a performance or competition may result in limited participation.

- Proper attire must be worn to every practice, including cheer shoes, practice wear, hair secured, and no jewelry.
- Phones should be put away during practice time.

4. Team Commitment

- Reign in Rhythm athletes are expected to maintain a positive attitude, demonstrate respect toward coaches, teammates, and competitors, and represent the program professionally at all times.
- Outside activities (sports, jobs, etc.) must not interfere with the team's schedule or commitment expectations.
- Participation in all scheduled competitions, showcases, and team events is mandatory unless excused by the coaching staff.
- Participation on a team does not guarantee placement in choreography, stunt groups, or competition routines. Athlete roles may change throughout the season based on attendance, skill progress, attitude, safety, and overall team needs. All decisions regarding routines and placements are at the discretion of the coaching staff.

5. Communication

- Families and athletes must remain responsive through designated communication channels (phone, email, band, etc.).
- Any issues or concerns should be discussed privately and respectfully with the coach or program director.
- Gossip, negativity, or disrespectful behavior toward staff, athletes, or other programs will not be tolerated.

6. Financial Responsibility

- All fees must be paid on or before the due date outlined in the financial agreement.
- Late payments may result in suspension from practice and events until the balance is paid in full.
- No refunds will be issued for missed practices, events, or early withdrawal.

7. Sportsmanship & Conduct

- Athletes and families are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times, both in-person and online.
- Bullying, harassment, or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disciplinary action, up to removal from the program.
- Social media posts that negatively reflect on Reign in Rhythm Cheer Co. or its members are grounds for removal without a refund.

8. Injury & Health

- Injuries must be reported to a coach immediately.
- Athletes cleared from injury must provide a doctor's note before returning to full participation.
- Maintaining physical conditioning and mental readiness outside of practice is part of the athlete's responsibility.

- Depending on the severity of the illness or injury, athletes may be required to attend practices and observe, even if they are not cleared for physical activity. This helps ensure athletes stay engaged, aware of team changes, and ready to transition back safely.

9. Program Integrity

- Attendance at all team events, fundraisers, and community initiatives is highly encouraged to support team unity.
- Athletes must respect all facilities and equipment used by Reign in Rhythm Cheer Co. or partner programs.
- The coaching staff and program director reserve the right to make all final decisions regarding team structure, choreography, competition participation, athlete roles, and placement adjustments as necessary for athlete safety and overall program success.

MANDATORY PROGRAM FUNDRAISERS

Fundraiser Schedule

- **Summer Fundraiser** (June/ July)
- **Winter Fundraiser** (December)
- **Spring Fundraiser** (March)

Funds raised will go toward:

- Program development needs
- End-of-season team celebration and athlete recognition

Participation in these fundraisers helps reduce overall program costs while allowing us to continue expanding opportunities for our athletes.

Fundraiser Participation Policy

Because these fundraisers directly support the athletes and program experience, participation is required for all team members. Families who choose not to participate in a scheduled fundraiser may opt out by submitting a **\$150 fundraiser buyout fee PER fundraiser**.

PARENT EXPECTATIONS

At Reign in Rhythm, parents and guardians play a vital role in each athlete's success. We ask all families to support our program's values of commitment, respect, and teamwork by following these expectations throughout the season.

Communication

- Direct all team-related questions or concerns through the proper communication channels (Band, email, or direct coach contact).
- Avoid addressing concerns during or immediately after practice — schedule a time to speak privately if needed.
- Keep coaches informed of any absences, injuries, or changes to your athlete's availability as soon as possible.

Support & Conduct

- Be a positive role model for your athlete and teammates.
- Display good sportsmanship at all events — toward athletes, other parents, coaches, and competing programs.
- Refrain from negative discussions about athletes, staff, or other teams in person or on social media.
- Trust the coaching staff's expertise regarding team placements, routine choreography, and competition decisions.

Attendance & Commitment

- Ensure your athlete arrives on time and prepared for all practices, camps, and competitions.
- Avoid scheduling vacations, appointments, or other activities that conflict with mandatory practices and events during competition season.
- Understand that the program's success depends on every athlete's consistency and dedication.

Financial Responsibility

- Stay current on all fees, tuition, and uniform payments according to the payment schedule.
- Late or missed payments may result in temporary suspension from practices or performances until the account is up to date.

CONSEQUENCES

Reign in Rhythm holds all athletes accountable for meeting program expectations and maintaining a positive, respectful environment. When expectations are not met, the following steps may be taken at the discretion of the coaching staff and program director:

1. **Verbal Warning or Reminder** – Used for first-time or minor issues.
2. **Written Notice and Parent Contact** – For continued or more serious concerns.
3. **Removal from Stunt Group, Section, or Performance** – Until improvement is shown.

4. **Alternate Status or Suspension** – For repeated violations or unexcused absences. *Athletes placed on alternate status remain active team members and may return to performance roles once expectations are met.*
5. **Dismissal from the Program** – Reserved for severe or ongoing issues.

**All disciplinary actions are handled with fairness, consistency, and respect. The goal is to guide athletes toward accountability, not punishment, while keeping the integrity and unity of each team intact

Financial Commitment Acknowledgment

Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company 2026–2027 Season

By accepting placement on a Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company All-Star team, I acknowledge and agree to the following:

Card on File Requirement

I understand a valid card on file is required for participation in the program and may be charged for any balances not received by the stated due dates.

Season Commitment

I understand that All-Star team participation is an **11-month commitment** beginning May 29, 2026 through Nationals in April 2027, and that I am responsible for all financial obligations during this time.

Monthly Tuition Payments

I understand monthly tuition is due on the **1st of each month**, with a grace period through the **15th**, after which a **\$35 late fee** will be applied.

Participation Eligibility

I understand athletes with balances past the grace period may become ineligible to participate in practices, choreography, or competitions until accounts are brought current.

Non-Prorated Tuition

I understand tuition is calculated across the season and is **not prorated** for missed practices, holidays, or shortened months.

Additional Charges

I understand additional charges may occur during the season, including competition-related costs, end-of-season fees, or late fees, and that advance notice will be provided before charges are processed.

Uniform & Athlete Package Costs

I understand required athlete items (including uniforms, practice wear, bows, shoes, and warm-ups) are billed separately according to program deadlines but are included in the total season cost estimates provided.

Tumbling Requirement

I understand tumbling for Novice, Prep, and Elite teams is **required** and billed separately through **Maverick Gymnastics**.

Stunt Group Training Requirement

I understand monthly stunt group training sessions are mandatory for Prep and Elite athletes and are included in tuition.

Discount Eligibility

I understand discount programs (Pay-in-Full, Sibling, and Class Discounts) apply only as outlined in the packet and do not apply to registration fees, tryout fees, end-of-season costs, or separately billed services unless otherwise stated.

Full-Season Financial Responsibility

I understand acceptance of team placement represents a commitment for the full competitive season and that program expenses are **non-refundable once incurred**, regardless of absence, withdrawal, injury, or dismissal from the program.

Waiver of Liability & Assumption of Risk Agreement

Participation in cheerleading, tumbling, stunting, conditioning, and related athletic activities involves inherent and significant risks of injury. By enrolling in Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company, I acknowledge and agree to the following on behalf of myself and/or my athlete.

1. Voluntary Participation & Assumption of Risk

I understand that participation in cheerleading activities includes risks such as slips, trips, falls, collisions with other athletes or individuals, equipment failure, overexertion, facility-related incidents, and other unforeseen circumstances that may result in injury, illness, property damage, emotional distress, permanent disability, or death.

I voluntarily accept full responsibility for these risks on behalf of myself and my athlete as a condition of participation and acknowledge that I have explained these risks to my athlete.

2. Release of Liability

I release and hold harmless Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company, its owners, directors, coaches, staff members, volunteers, facility partners, and affiliates from any claims arising from participation in practices, classes, camps, clinics, choreography sessions, competitions, travel activities, or related events.

This release applies to injuries or damages caused by:

- participation in cheer activities
- other athletes or spectators
- equipment use or failure
- facility conditions

- third-party actions
- negligence of other participants or visitors

except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct.

3. Promise Not to Sue

In consideration of participation in Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company activities, I agree not to bring legal action against Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company, its staff, affiliates, or facility partners for injuries or damages arising from participation in program activities.

This agreement is binding on myself, my athlete, and our heirs, representatives, administrators, and assigns.

4. Facility & Third-Party Location Acknowledgment

I understand that Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company may conduct practices, training sessions, or events at partner facilities or rented training locations. Participation at these locations carries the same risks outlined in this agreement.

5. Equipment & Third-Party Vendor Acknowledgment

I understand that injuries may occur as a result of equipment use, facility setup, or actions of third-party vendors, manufacturers, installers, or service providers. I accept these risks as part of participation.

6. Competition & Travel Acknowledgment

I understand that participation on a Reign In Rhythm team may involve travel to competitions, events, performances, or team activities. I acknowledge that transportation to and from these events is the responsibility of the parent/guardian unless otherwise communicated in writing by the program.

I accept the risks associated with travel participation and release Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company and its staff from liability related to transportation, lodging arrangements, or supervision outside designated team activity times.

7. Medical Authorization

In the event of an emergency, I authorize Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company staff to obtain medical treatment for my athlete if I cannot be reached immediately. I understand that all medical expenses remain the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

8. Insurance Responsibility

I understand that Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company does not provide individual medical insurance coverage for athletes and that maintaining personal medical insurance is required.

9. Media Release

I grant permission for Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company to photograph or record my athlete for promotional, social media, website, and marketing purposes unless written notice requesting exclusion is submitted.

10. Agreement to Policies, Expectations & Financial Agreement

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have received, read, and fully understand the Reign In Rhythm Cheer Company 2026–2027 Season Information Packet & Agreement in its entirety. I agree to comply with all policies, expectations, participation requirements, financial obligations, waivers, and program guidelines outlined within for the duration of the season.

I understand that failure to comply with these policies and requirements may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or removal from the program without refund where applicable.
